What We Offer

Weekly Individual Supervision

Ongoing clinical guidance and support to help you grow in confidence and competence.

Bi-Weekly Intern Meetings

Every other Thursday at 2:00 PM (Virtual)

Collaborate, consult, and connect with fellow interns.

Monthly Clinical Team Meetings

4th Wednesday of every month at 11:00 AM (Virtual)

Engage with our full clinical team and participate in case consultation.

Monthly Intern Seminar

One Thursday morning per month at 8:00 AM (Virtual)

Focused training and skill-building opportunities.

Session Observation Opportunities

When available and with client consent, interns may observe sessions to enhance learning.

Office Access

Interns are provided keys to office locations.

Client Availability

General Idea of Preferred Availability:

- Evenings and weekend mornings
- 2-8pm during the week
- 9am-1pm weekends

These above-mentioned slots tend to fill the fastest and are most in demand. *Not every day you are interning must be those exact hours, though at least one late evening is required.*

Three days per week is preferred.

Practice at Multiple Locations
